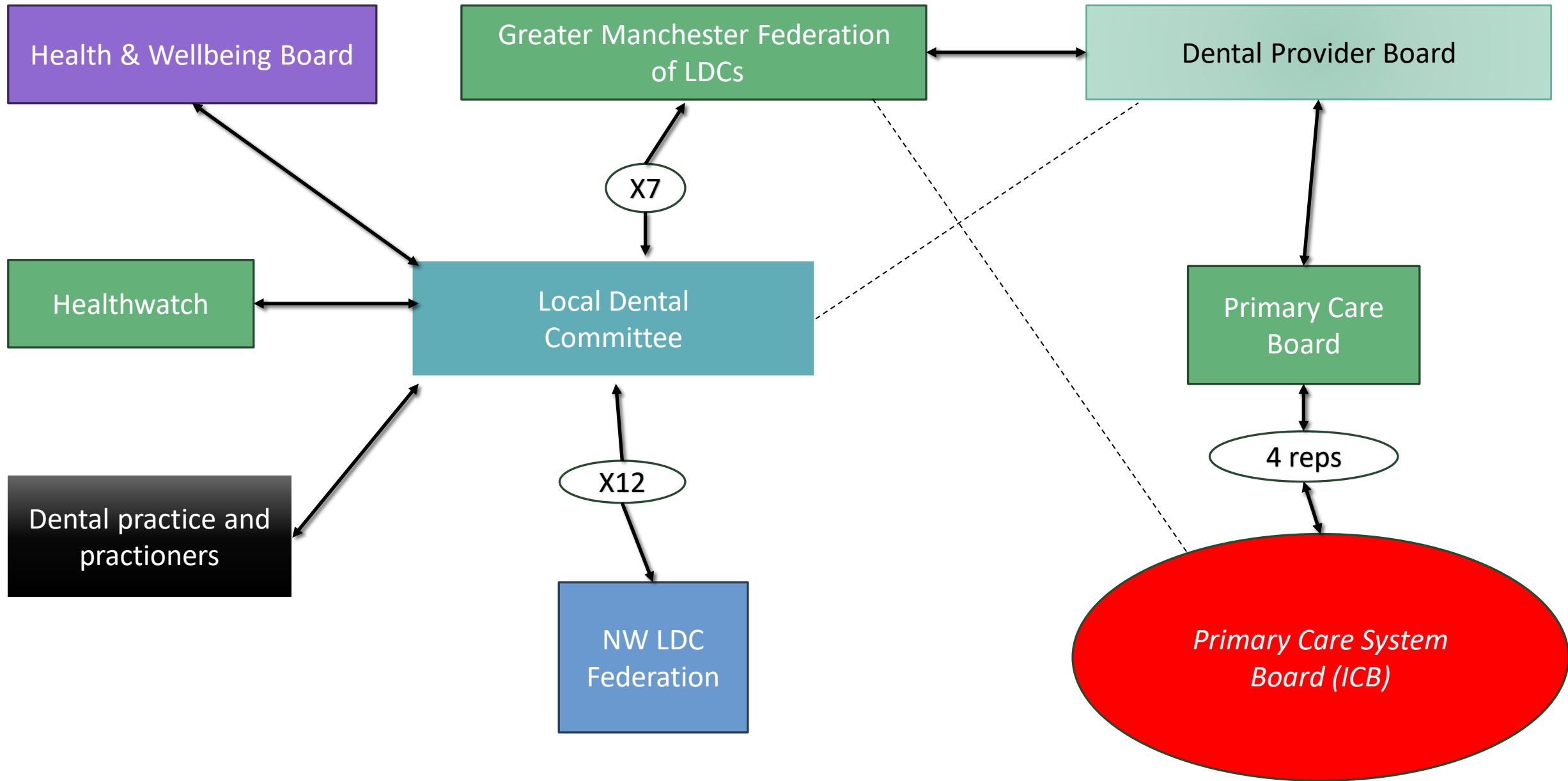

Dental Provider Board

The DPB represents providers of primary dental care via its membership, attendance and contribution to the Primary Care Provider Board (PCPB)

Ensure that Dentistry is appropriately represented at key GM board and groups

DPB advises the Primary Care Board of the views and abilities of Primary Dental providers with a unified voice.

Consult with colleagues and bring a depth of expertise, experience, and knowledge to the PCPB

Develop a workplan that clearly outlines the direction and key priorities which are in alignment with Primary Care strategy and identifies priorities that will benefit Dental Practices, their staff and patients in terms of value and outcomes

Cascade information in both directions in order to give and receive feedback.

Primary Care System Board (ICB)

Brings together Senior Primary Care Commissioner, Primary Care Provider leadership and Finance.

Meets 2 times a week responding to system pressures, SITREP reports for Primary Care

Reporting on Vaccination Programs

New initiatives (Spirometry service) are presented to be scrutinised.

Other parts of Primary care such as Workforce or Digital update on workstreams

Can initiate Task and finish groups such as Primary Care blueprint

Scrutinise projects such as Winter Pressure planning.

Results

178 Practice Joined 50%, all reception teams navigating patients.

Representing > 50% commissioned UDAs

9500 new patient per month, 58520 to 23/10

8500 Urgent care patients per month 54869

1800 FTA/ month ~20%

Soft launch to give Practice confidence and train reception teams.

Regular GM meetings with Practices to share good practice such as optimising cancelled slots

Increase in demand seeing no of telephone calls up, with spikes when local groups broadcast.

Dentistry has a good news story to share with partners creating a positive message.

This scheme does not and cannot meet all demand
